

## **Developing Future Leaders for the Equine Industry January 5 and 12, 2010, 8:30 AM – 4:30 PM**

**New Jersey Museum of Agriculture

This two-day short course is directed toward those involved in New Jersey's equine industry. Developed and offered by the Rutgers Equine Science Center, the course brings together a team of instructors led by Karyn Malinowski, Ph.D., director of the Equine Science Center and Mary Nikola, Ed.D., director of leadership and organizational development with the New Jersey Agricultural Experiment Station. Topics include the value of the equine industry, networking and relationship-building, decision-making strategies, leadership practices and behaviors, building coalitions, and industry management. Past graduates of the course are currently engaged in existing New Jersey equine-related organizations, such as the NJ Equine Advisory Board and Horse Council.

**Workshop Presenters:** Include leaders in state government, agriculture, and the horse industry.

## **DIRECTIONS TO THE NEW JERSEY MUSEUM OF AGRICULTURE**

### **NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE – NORTH OR SOUTH**

Take the NJ Turnpike to Exit 9 – New Brunswick

After the toll, stay to the right & get onto Route 18 North

Follow Route 18 North to Route 1 South

Follow Route 1 South to the third exit – College Farm Rd (approx. 30 seconds)

Make a right onto College Farm Rd

The Museum is the first building on the right, there is a windmill in the front of the building.

### **GARDEN STATE PARKWAY – FROM THE SOUTH**

Take Exit 129 – New Jersey Turnpike

Take the NJ Turnpike to Exit 9 – New Brunswick

Follow the directions above

### **GARDEN STATE PARKWAY – FROM THE NORTH**

Take Exit 130 – Route 1 South

Follow Route 1 South over the Raritan River – (when you pass Loew’s Theater, about 10 minutes)

Take the fourth exit after Loew’s theater – College Farm Rd

Make a right onto College Farm Rd

The Museum is the first building on the right – there is a windmill in front of the building

### **ROUTE 1 FROM THE NORTH**

Follow the directions above after you get off of the parkway

### **ROUTE 1 FROM THE SOUTH**

Note: Construction on Route 1, Revised Directions as of 07-19-09.

Take Route 1 North, pass the Route 130 Interchange, to Ryders Lane (to New Brunswick)

Follow the ramp up onto Ryders Lane, and then down the next ramp to Route 1 South

Merge on to Route 1 South

Take the next exit - College Farm Rd - This is the entrance to the Cook Campus of Rutgers University.

Make a right on to College Farm Rd

The Museum is the first building on the right - there is a windmill in front of the building.

### **ROUTE 287 FROM THE NORTH**

Take 287 to Exit 9

Make a right onto River Rd

Take River Rd to Route 18 South

Take 18 South to Route 1 South

Take Route 1 South to the third exit – College Farm Rd

The Museum is the first building on the right – there will be a windmill in front of the building.
